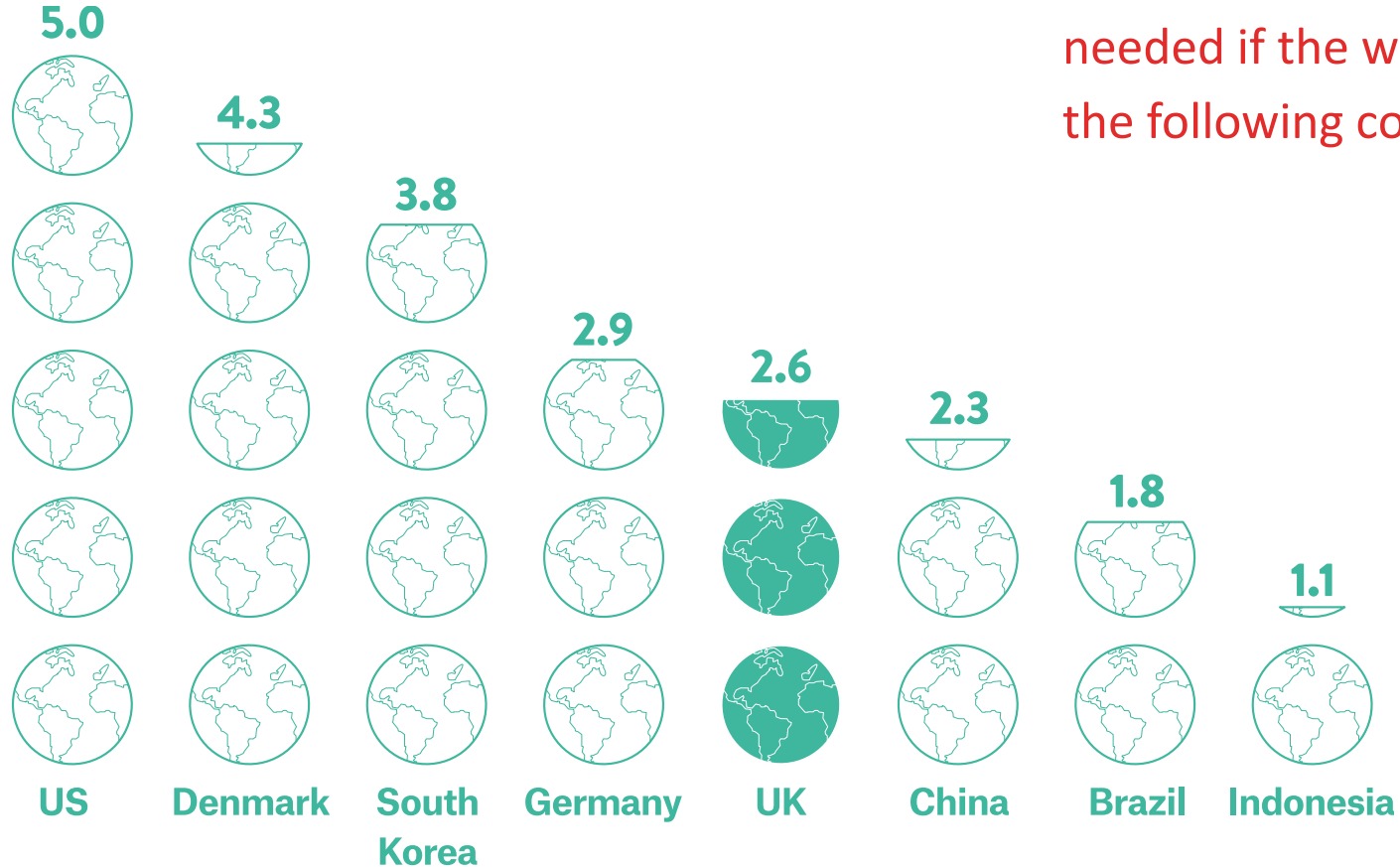

- Carbon emissions from fossil fuels will hit record levels in 2022 (COP 27 study)
- Decline needed to cut emissions by half by 2030 to restrict global heating to 1.5C - no sign of this !

## Background..

- Increasing scrutiny throughout the food and pharma value chain brings with it the need for commitment, engagement, transparency and disclosure.
- An understanding of emerging issues enables a sustainability context to be formed and a business case to be developed in addressing challenges and turning these into business benefits.
- Whether it is accounting for, managing energy consumption through facilities and transport, quantifying and disclosing GHG emissions, or measuring and managing **ethical risks** in the supply chain
- SDGs are presented as a set of goals and targets that any organisation can take up and commit to; society as a whole needs to achieve them if it is turn the corner :

169 individual targets defined – applicable across sectors/organisations/communities etc



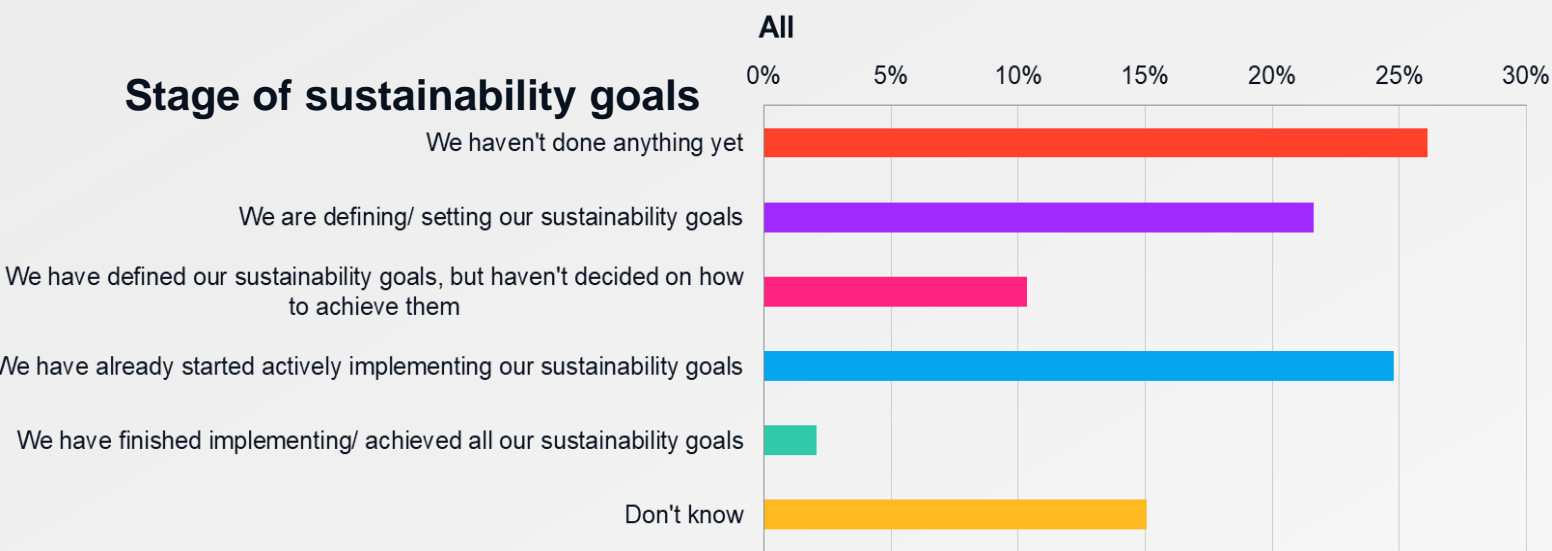

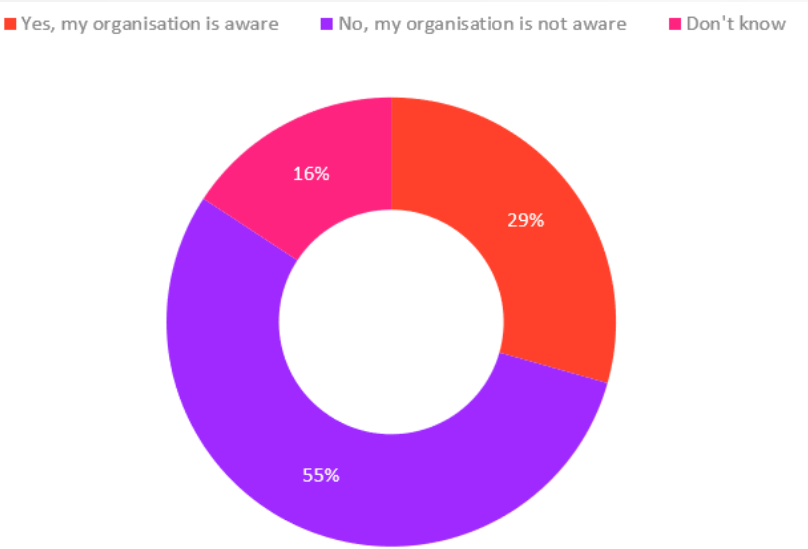
# Sustainability Research

## Conducted with YouGov March 2022

- Over 1,000 respondents
- Industry wide across all sectors (private) and all sizes of organizations
- Job title – Managerial level or above
- Data can be sliced by industry
- Results show the majority of organizations haven't started their sustainability journey



## Awareness of UN SDGs



# Some key findings - Conducted with YouGov March 2022

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## Awareness

- Large organizations are much more aware of UN SDGs (46% aware vs 18% of SMEs), note 249 employees is the cut off
- Only 15% of organizations less than 50 employees are aware of UN SDGs

## Priorities

- The target of Net Zero is perceived as much more of a priority for larger organizations (51% have it as a priority theme) than SMEs (33%)
- Human Wellbeing is perceived as the most important sustainability theme with 49% of organizations saying it is a priority.

## Progress

- 26% of organizations haven't done anything yet, regarding their sustainability goals (38% of SMEs vs 8% of Large organizations).
- 25% state they are actively implementing the goals
- Only 2% of organizations believe they have finished implementing or achieving their sustainability goals

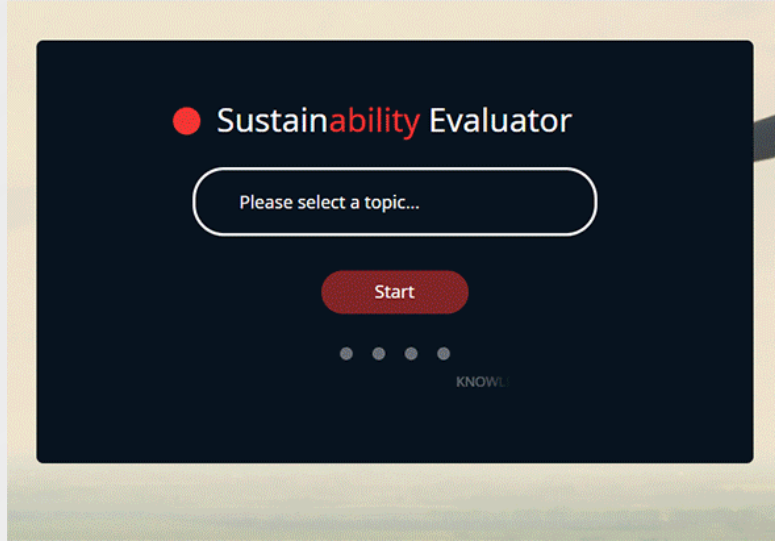

# BSI's Sustainability Evaluator

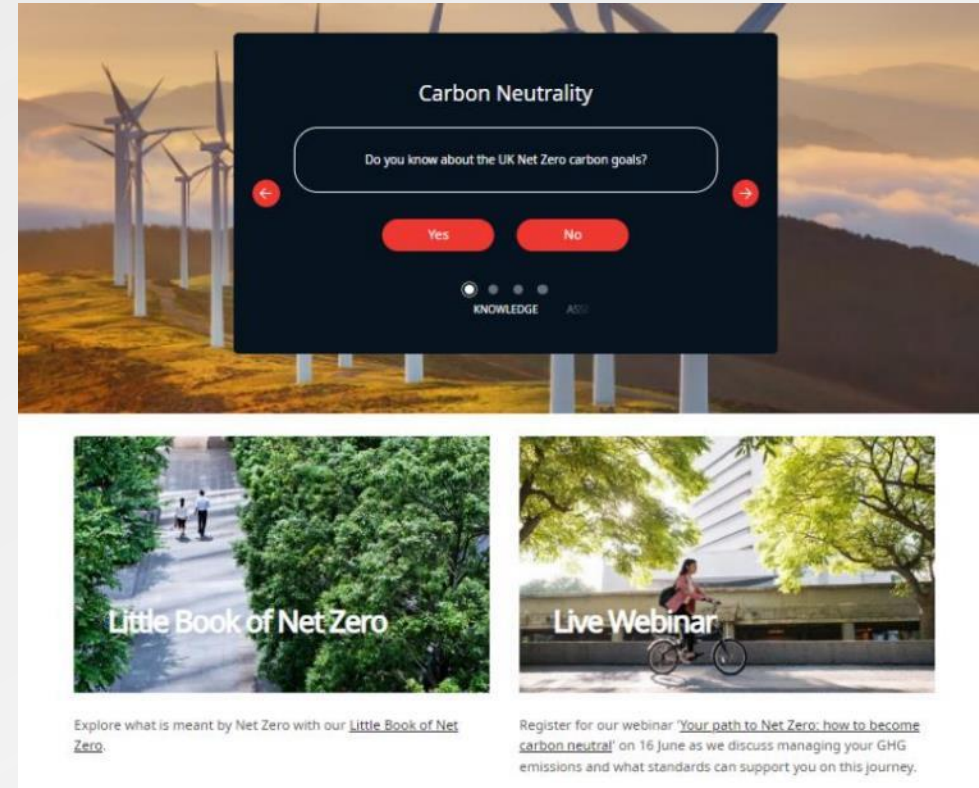


## First Screen

- Uses drop down to select topic (so we can add topics as we build them)

## Topics (aligned to products)

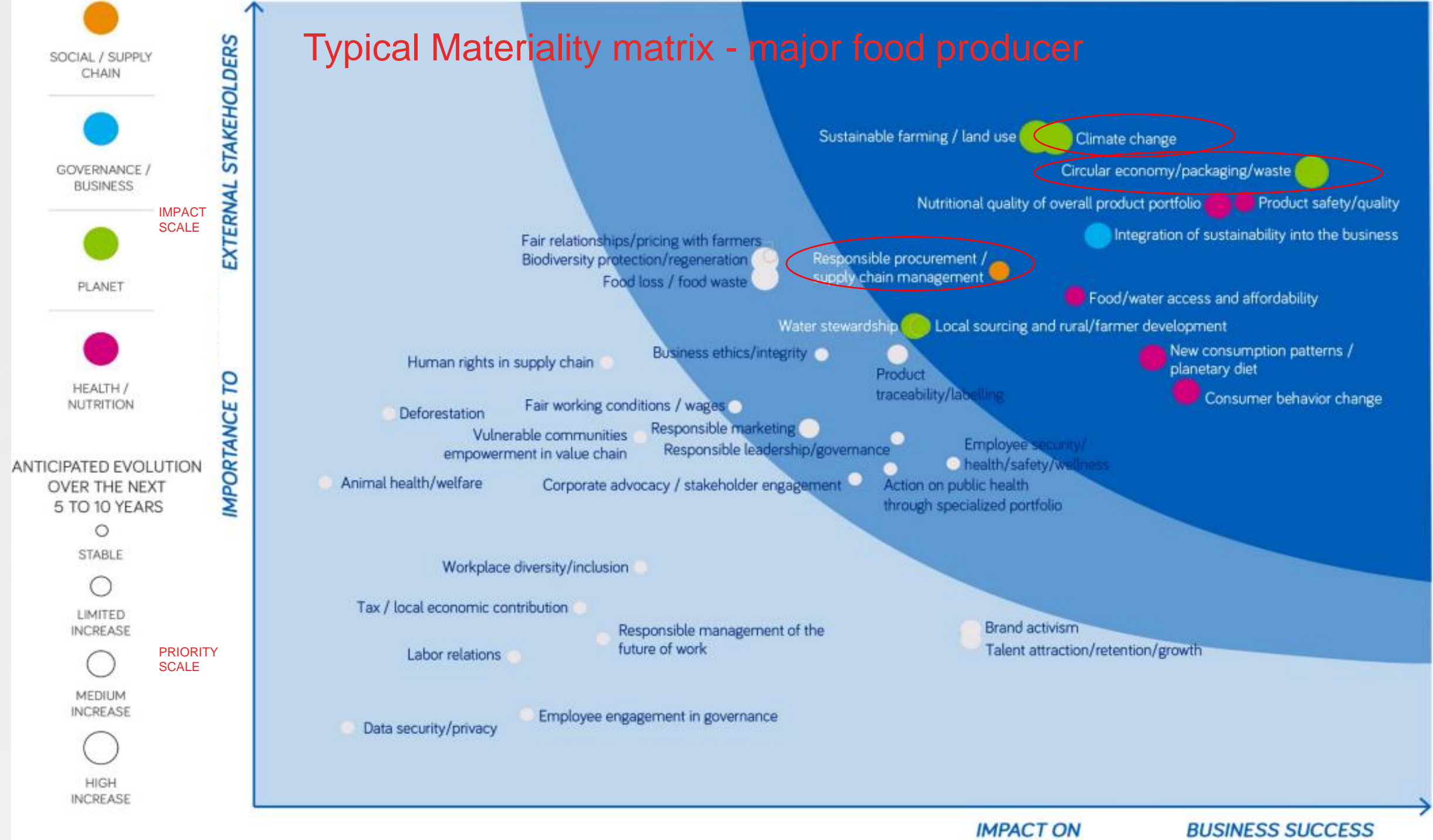
- Carbon Neutrality

## Subsequent Screens – topic areas questions and answers

- Scrolls through a series of four questions
- When 'yes' is clicked it moves to next question
- When 'no' is clicked it presents bottom block with information
- At the end of the question series it presents a web to lead form

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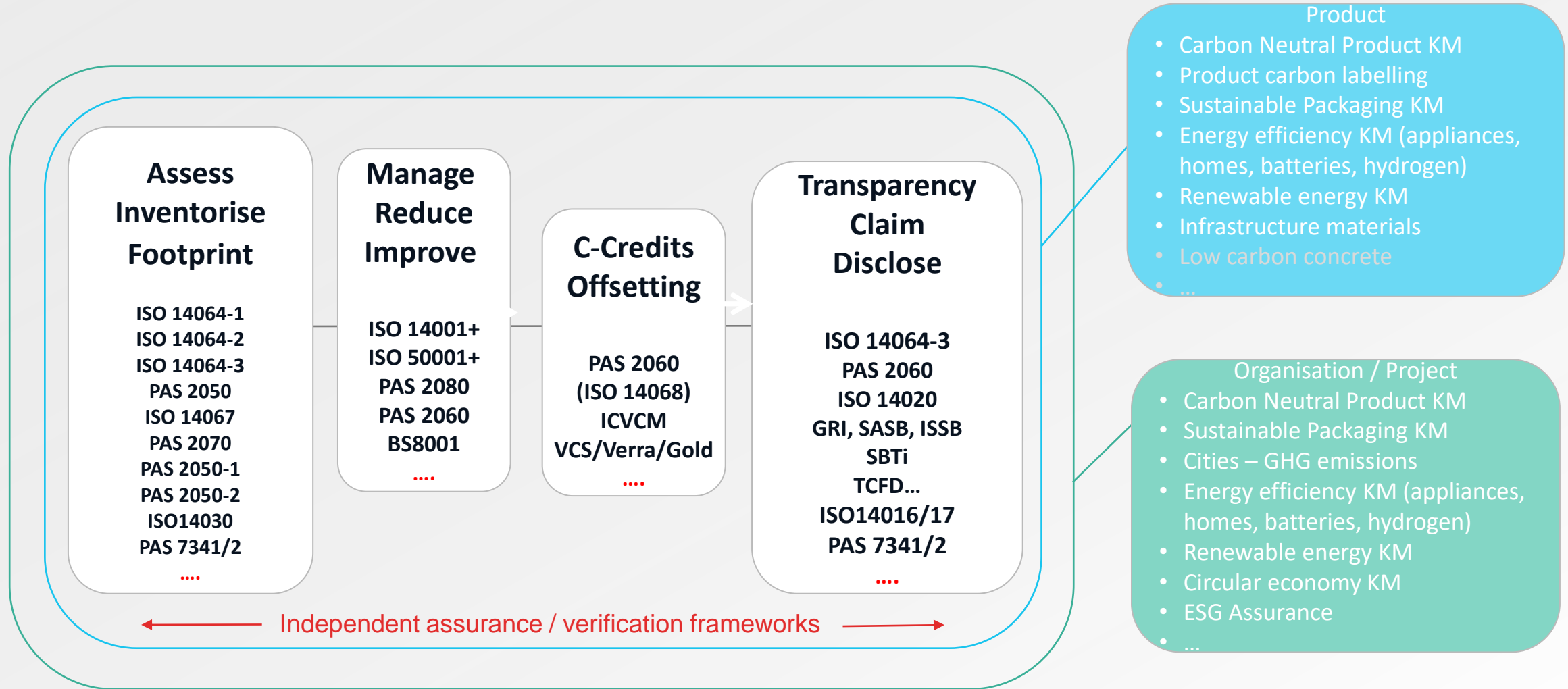

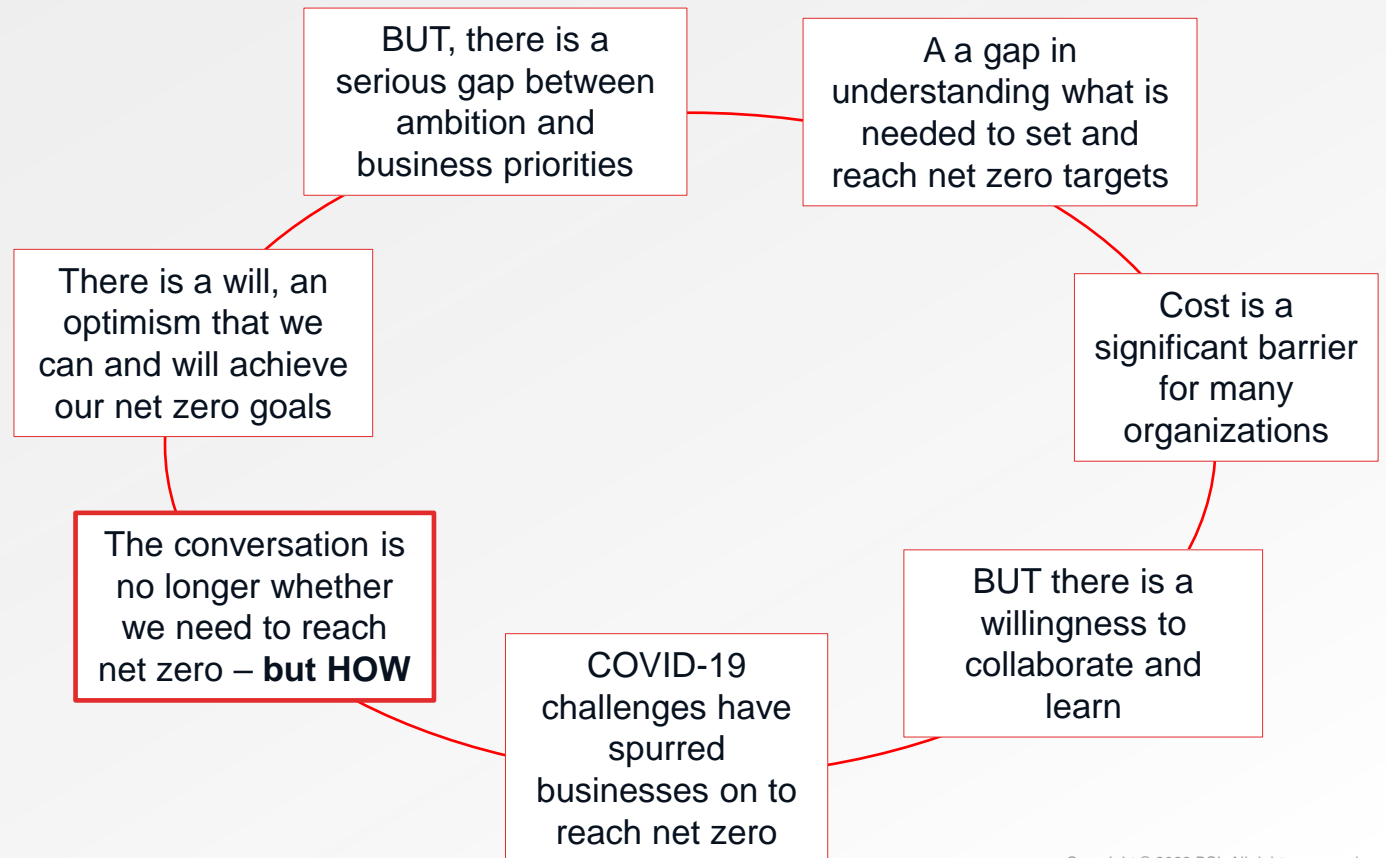

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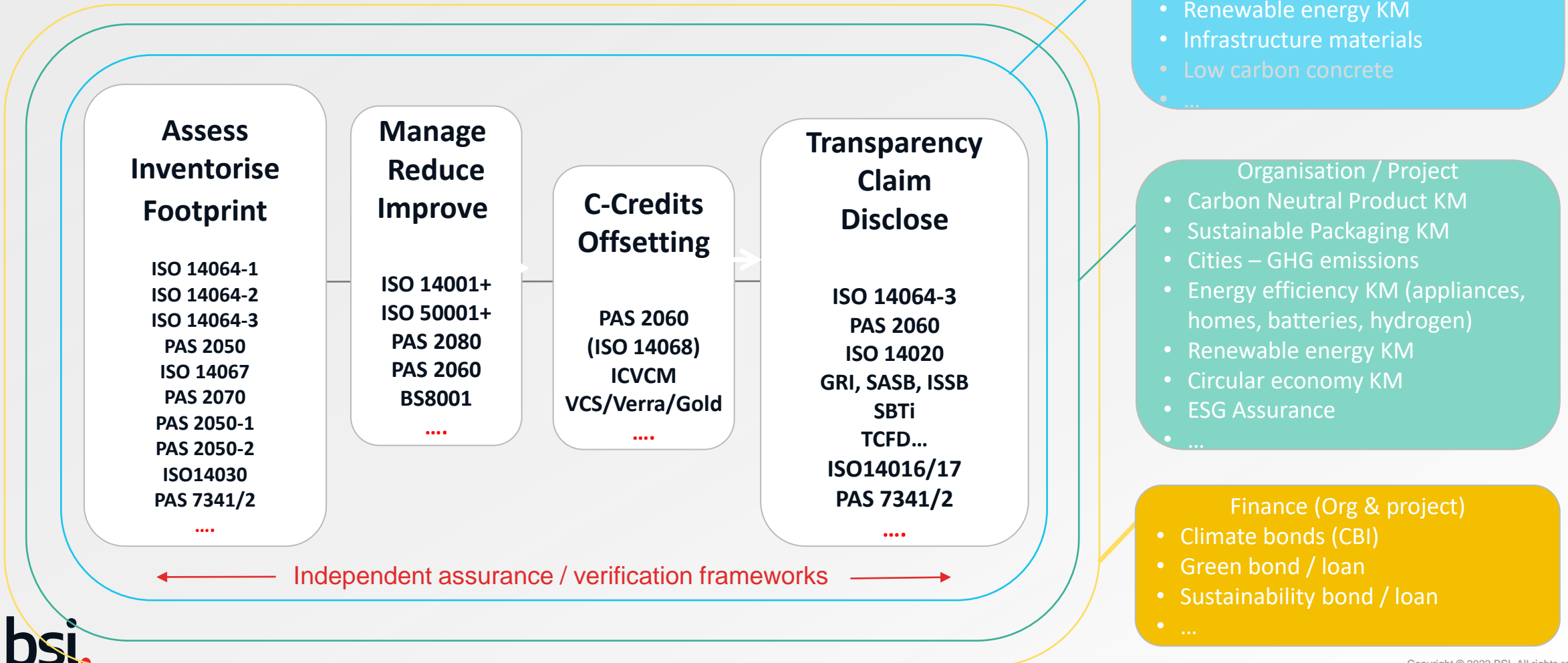

# Client Carbon Journey

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## What came out of COP 27?

*We must close the emissions gap before climate catastrophe closes in on us all.*

— UN Secretary-General António Guterres

UNEP's Emissions Gap Report 2022 estimates that to get on a least-cost pathway to limiting global warming to 2°C and 1.5°C, emissions must fall by 30% and by 45%, respectively

countries' nationally determined contributions (NDCs), updated since the 2021 Glasgow Climate Change Conference (UNFCCC COP 26), make a “negligible” difference to predicted 2030 emissions and that progress since COP 26 has been “woefully inadequate



## What came out of COP 27:

- defined a way forward on a decades-long conversation on funding for addressing loss and damage for vulnerable countries.
- governments agreeing on the way to move forward on the Global Goal on Adaptation, which will conclude at COP28 and inform the first **Global Stocktake**, improving resilience amongst the most vulnerable and a mechanism to raise ambition under the Paris Agreement
- the launch of a new five-year work program at COP27 to promote climate technology solutions in developing countries
- a mitigation work programme was launched to urgently scale up ambition and implementation, under which Governments are requested to revisit and strengthen the 2030 targets in their national climate plans by the end of 2023, and accelerate efforts to phasedown unabated coal power and phase-out inefficient fossil fuel subsidies.
- announced a USD 3.1 billion plan to ensure everyone on the planet is protected by early warning systems within the next five years
- launch of the Forest and Climate Leaders' Partnership, which aims to unite action by governments, businesses and community leaders to halt forest loss and land degradation by 2030
- global transformation to a low-carbon economy is expected to require investments of at least USD 4-6 trillion a year – this will require a swift and comprehensive transformation of the financial system
